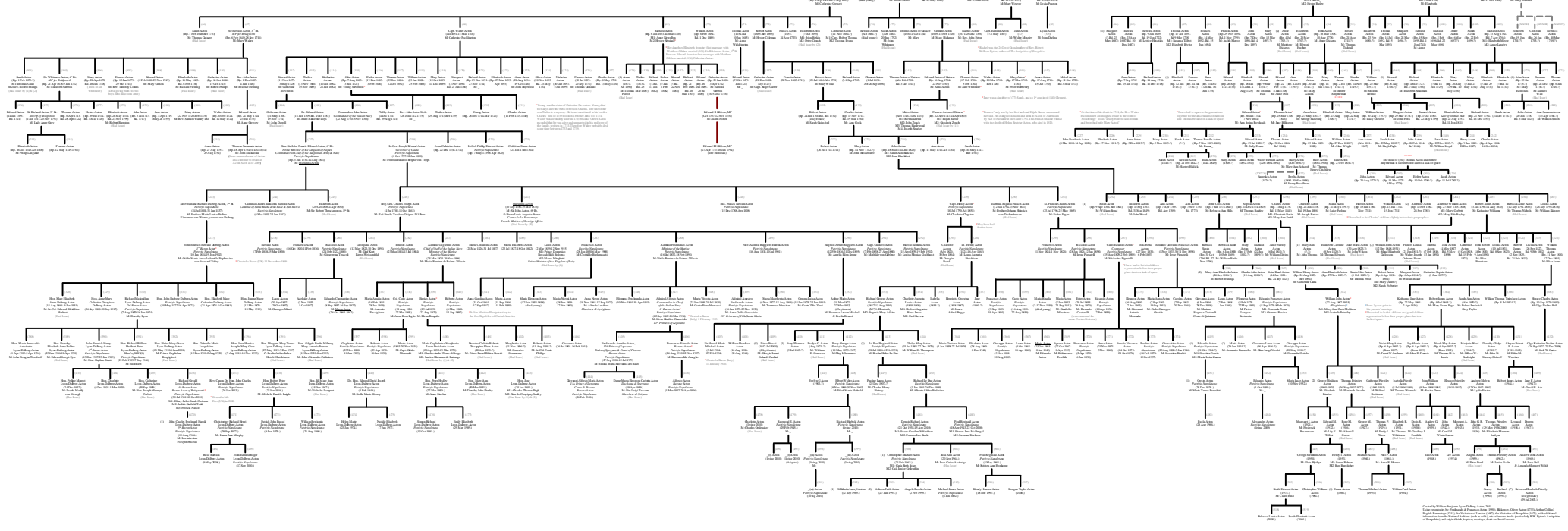
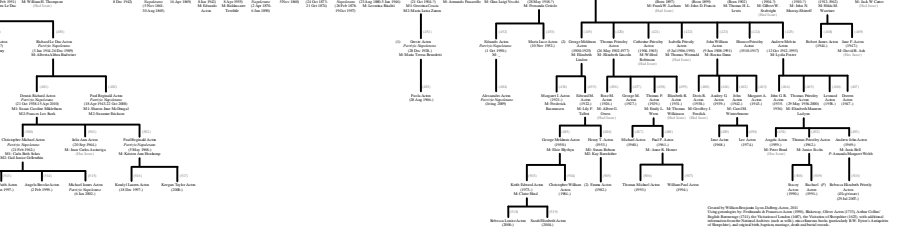
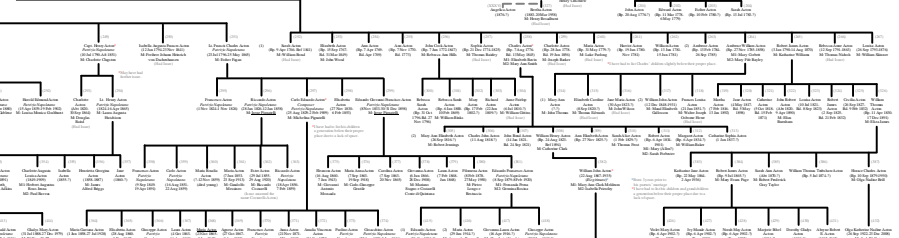
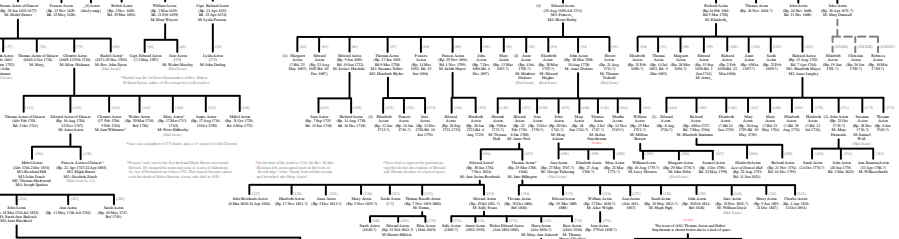
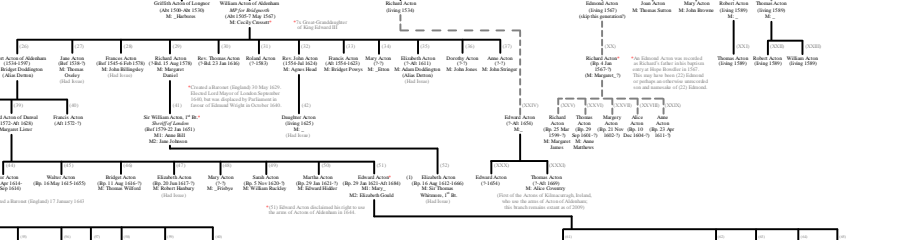
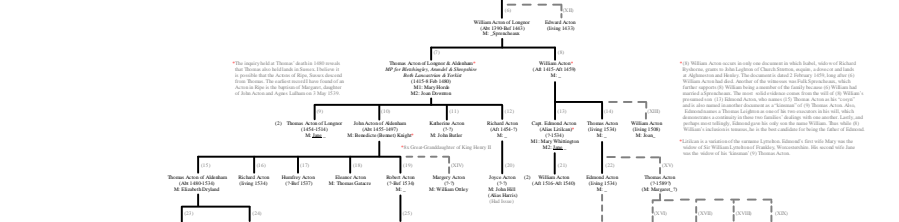
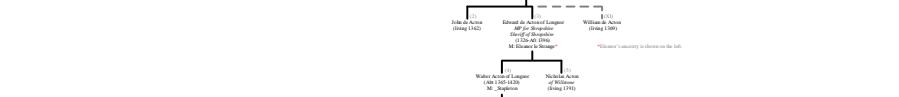
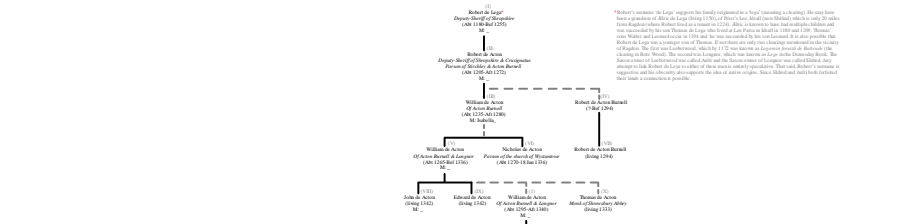
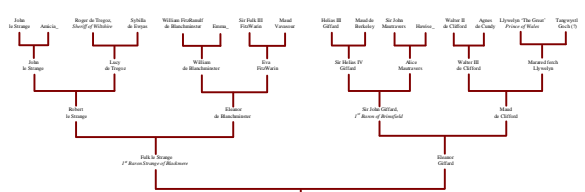




Arms of the House of Lancaster, as borne by the House of Lancaster, as a cadet branch of the House of Plantagenet.
